#### About

The program offers by Jan Evangelista Purkyne University (UJEP) and Nha Trang University. The program was started in 2010, usually, NTU receive students from UJEP to study at NTU from 3 to 4 months.

Studying at NTU, UJEP students has chances to explore Vietnamese marine biodiversity, environment and resource management by attending lectures and field trips to Marine Protected Area, marine sea cage culture and factories in Khanh Hoa and nearby provinces.
