Memorandum of Understanding

Between

LUNGHWA UNIVERSITY OF SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY, TAIWAN

And

NHA TRANG UNIVERSITY, VIETNAM

On

Academic and Research Collaboration

WHEREAS, Lunghwa University of Science and Technology, Taiwan and Nha Trang University, Vietnam are mutually interested in establishing collaboration on academic and research related development activities;

WHEREAS, the two bodies have discussed the furtherance of these interests and now desire to record their mutual understandings in this regard:

NOW, THEREFORE, both parties hereby record their understanding.

ARTICLE I

The purpose of this Memorandum of Understanding is to develop and carry out collaborative activities in furtherance of the common interest of the institutions set forth in ARTICLE II.

ARTICLE II

The scope of collaboration on academic and research activities included in this Memorandum of Understanding includes the following categories:

- 1. Exchange of students
- 2. Exchange of faculty members
- 3. Exchange course materials
- 4. Research collaboration
- 5. Joint Degree Programs

ARTICLE III

To implement the aims and purposes expressed in ARTICLE I and II, the following is mutually understood and agreed:

- 1. Proposals for collaborative work under this Memorandum will be submitted through the nominees of Lunghwa University of Science and Technology and Nha Trang University.
- 2. Each party will nominate one of its members as its representative in charge of the cooperative program. Individual programs of work under this Memorandum will be jointly planned and conducted by the nominees of both parties.
- 3. Progress of work by the individual program will be reviewed and approved by designated project officers of both parties. It is anticipated that a detailed plan of joint activities will be completed by the nominees of both parties.
- 4. The final approval of any project will be dependent upon the availability of guaranteed support funds.
- 5. Neither Lunghwa University of Science and Technology nor Nha Trang University will be held

responsible for any liability whatsoever; furthermore, neither party shall be required to purchase any insurance against loss or damage to any personal property to which this agreement relates.

ARTICLE IV

- 1. This Memorandum of Understanding is effective as of the date of execution by the appropriate officer of each signatory institution.
- 2. This Memorandum of Understanding may be amended at any time by mutual consent and shall continue in force and effect for five years and can be extended by mutual consent of both parties.
- 3. This Memorandum of Understanding is signed in four identical copies in English and Vietnamese of the same value, of which each signatory receives one English copy and one Vietnamese copy.
