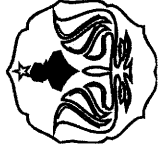




Memorandum of Understanding

NHA TRANG UNIVERSITY, VIETNAM



And

JENDERAL SOEDIRMAN UNIVERSITY, PURWOKERTO, INDONESIA

On **Academic and Research Collaboration**

WHEREAS, Nha Trang University, Vietnam and Jenderal Soedirman University, Purwokerto, Indonesia are mutually interested in establishing collaboration on academic and research related development activities;

WHEREAS, two parties have discussed the furtherance of these interests and now desire to record their mutual understandings in this regard;

NOW, THEREFORE, both parties hereby record their understandings.

ARTICLE I

The purpose of this Memorandum of Understanding is to develop and carry out collaborative activities in furtherance of the common interest of the institutions set forth in ARTICLE II.

ARTICLE II

The scope of collaboration on academic and research activities included in this Memorandum of Understanding includes the following categories:

1. Exchange of students
2. Exchange of faculty members
3. Exchange course materials
4. Research collaboration

ARTICLE III

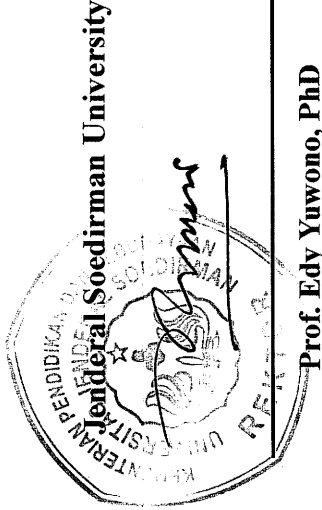
To implement the aims and purposes expressed in ARTICLE I and II, the followings are mutually understood and agreed:

1. Proposals for collaborative work under this Memorandum will be submitted through the nominees of Nha Trang University and Jenderal Soedirman University.
2. Each party will nominate one of its members as its representative in charge of the cooperative program. Individual programs of work under this Memorandum will be jointly planned and conducted by the nominees of both parties.
3. Progress of work by the individual program will be reviewed and approved by designated project officers of both parties. It is anticipated that a detailed plan of joint activities will be completed by the nominees of both parties.
4. The final approval of any project will be dependent upon the availability of guaranteed support funds.

5. Neither Nha Trang University nor Jenderal Soedirman University will be held responsible for any liability whatsoever; furthermore, neither party shall be required to purchase any insurance against loss or damage to any personal property to which this agreement relates.

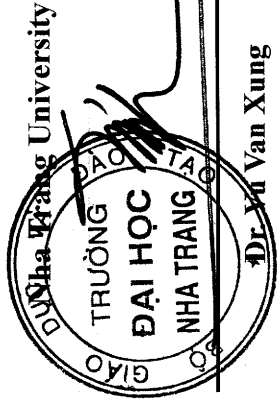
ARTICLE IV

1. This Memorandum of Understanding is effective as of the date of execution by the appropriate officer of each signatory institution.
2. This Memorandum of Understanding may be amended at any time by mutual consent and shall continue in force and effect for five years and can be extended by mutual consent of both parties.
3. This Memorandum of Understanding is signed in two identical copies in English of the same value, of which each signatory receives one copy.
