

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

BETWEEN

THE UNIVERSITY OF STIRLING

AND

NHA TRANG UNIVERSITY

1. The University of Stirling and Nha Trang University hereby agree to encourage academic cooperation through research and study in furtherance of the advancement of learning as stipulated below:
 - (1) To encourage visits to departments/faculty from one university to the other for the purpose of engaging in educational activities and joint research;
 - (2) To facilitate the admission of qualified students from one university to the other for the purpose of enrolling in graduate programmes, and in the case of advanced graduate students, participating in research. In particular to facilitate the provision of taught MSc and post graduate research programmes in Aquaculture and related subjects;
 - (3) To foster the exchange of academic publications and scholarly information; and
 - (4) To promote other academic activities which enhance the above mentioned goals.
2. Both universities acknowledge that visits by department/faculty and students from one university to the other shall be subject to the entry and visa regulations of the United Kingdom and Vietnam and shall comply with the regulations and policies of the University of Stirling and Nha Trang University.
3. Both universities agree that all expenses, including research and teaching material, international and domestic travel, per diem, honoraria and all other costs, shall be as agreed in negotiated contracts.
4. Both universities agree to review this Memorandum of Understanding after five years following the date of signing. It shall be automatically renewed for successive five-year periods unless either party gives the other written notice of its desire to either terminate or revise this Memorandum twelve months prior to the termination of a given five-year period.

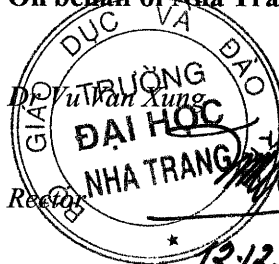
